Going to Dundonald International Ice Bowl



You are going to Dundonald International Ice Bowl because you are going to go:

- Ice Skating
- Tenpin Bowling
- Play in Indiana Land

Who will be going to the Ice Bowl with you?

There are lots of ways that you can get to the Ice Bowl

By Bus

You will get off the bus outside Dundonald International Ice Bowl.

The bus may look like this:



By Taxi

You will get out of a taxi outside Dundonald International Ice Bowl.

The Taxi may look like this:



By Car

You will be parking in an outdoor car park

This is what our staff look like in uniform:




Which activity are you going to do?

This is what Indiana Land Reception looks like:




Tenpin Bowling

Tenpin Bowling is very enjoyable!

You need to queue at the Bowling Centre Reception to get your lane turned on.

This is what the Bowling Centre Reception looks like:



Some of the bowling balls are very heavy depending on what colour they are. Make sure you don't lift one that's too heavy! Ask for help if you don't know what colour to lift.

Ear defenders are available to borrow if you need them or have forgotten your own, sometimes it can be very noisy when all the bowling pins are being knocked down!

Ice Skating

Ice Skating is fantastic fun! There will be colourful lights and music playing to make your time on the ice more exciting. If it gets too noisy for you, ear defenders are available to borrow.

If you don't feel confident on the ice we have Penguin and Snowmen skating aids available to help you as long as you are under 1.5m tall! A member of staff will be happy to help you get one but sometimes you may have to wait until one becomes available.

What if I need help?

Make sure you always stay close to whoever you came with and tell them if you are worried or have any questions.

If you are lost or need help, make sure you ask a member of staff, they are always happy to assist you!
